- **Serve one another.** (John 13:1-20; Galatians 5:13)
- **Bear one another's burdens.** (Galatians 6:2)
- **Be honest with one another.** (Colossians 3:9)
- **Encourage one another.** (1 Thessalonians 5:11)
- **Confess to one another.** (James 5:16)
- **Pray for one another.** (James 5:16)
- **Forgive one another.** (Ephesians 4:32)
- **Submit to one another.** (Ephesians 5:21)
- **Admonish one another.** (Colossians 3:16)
